AFRICA: TRENDS & CHALLENGES

- YOUTH POPULATION IN AFRICA EXPECTED TO DOUBLE TO OVER 830 MILLION BY 2050 (ILO 2017).
- 10 MILLION YOUTH ENTER AFRICA'S LABOUR MARKET ANNUALLY
- YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA WAS APPROX. 11% IN 2016 (ILO)
- ONLY 16% OF YOUTH HAVE A 'WAGE JOB', WHILE 62% WORK ON FAMILY FARMS AND 22% IN HOUSEHOLD ENTERPRISES.
- AT THE US\$3.1/DAY LEVEL, THE WORKING POVERTY RATE IN SUB SAHARAN AFRICA WAS NEARLY 70% IN 2016 (ILO)
- 38% YOUTH IN SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA DEMONSTRATE WILLINGNESS TO MOVE TO ANOTHER COUNTRY: GLOBALLY 20% (ILO)
- THE AVERAGE AGE OF FARMERS IN AFRICA IS ABOUT 55 YEARS (WTO, 2015)


THOUGHT & ACTION...









Project proposals by country
